Role Outline: Growth Group Leaders

Small groups in The Parish of Ockbrook & Borrowash are known as 'Growth Groups'. There are several groups in the parish, each with 4-10 members and a defined Leader. They generally meet weekly or biweekly (every other week) in Leaders' (or other members') homes. Typically, they undertake one or more of worship, bible study, prayer, and provide some level of pastoral support for members.

Responsible to	Growth Group Co-ordinator
Key Responsibilities of the Role (tasks to be undertaken)	
• Arrange Growth Group meetings as is customary for the group. This includes where & when to meet and any content • Ensure that content of meetings is consistent with Parish Purpose, Values & Priorities • Facilitate Growth Group meetings to ensure that members are all equally involved • Welcome any new members to their group and ensure their integration • Attend coordination meetings for Growth Group Leaders from time to time when possible	
Practical arrangements relevant to the role (e.g., times the role should be carried out.)	
Growth Group Meetings held where, when and how is customary for each respective Group	
Role to be reviewed (insert date)	Annually by the new PCC in May/June.
The role is eligible for a criminal record (DBS) check which is renewable every three years.	Yes
